About the Principals

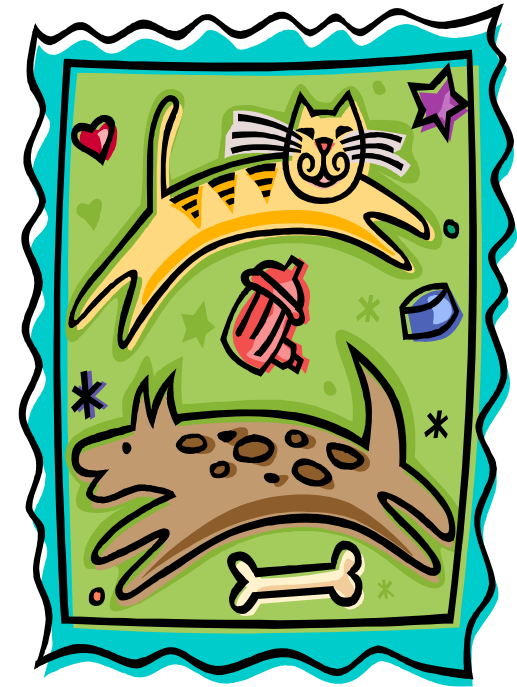

Result? Happy, healthy, well-adjusted pets who calmly and happily greet you every time you come home.

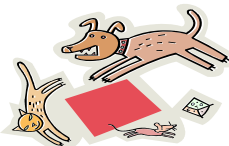


Is It Right For You?
